PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The purpose of the position is the provision of high quality welding trade duties for the effective maintenance and repairs to systems and equipment in accordance with TasPorts operations.

KEY DUTIES

- Undertake and ensure, with the direction of the Assistant Site Coordinator, that all welding repairs and maintenance requirements of appropriate infrastructure, property, plant and equipment are identified and attended to in an efficient and timely manner.
- Modify and maintain complex mechanical equipment and facilities to prescribed operational, technical and safety standards.
- Operate under defined procedures and work schedules.
- Carry out investigation of system performance to ensure continued integrity of service is provided.
- Analyse complex system faults and carry out associated maintenance.
- Provide after hours and standby callout services in relation to maintenance and repairs, and perform other related duties as requested.

LEVEL OF RESPONSIBILITY / ACCOUNTABILITY

Reporting to the Assistant Site Coordinator, the incumbent must demonstrate the required skills and knowledge of the trade to perform their duties. The incumbent must demonstrate good interpersonal, stakeholder liaison and communication skills.

6. Willingness to undertake overtime and out of hours work to meet operational requirements
7. Thorough and current understanding of both Occupational Health and Safety requirements and responsibilities and relevant industry legislation.
